Dear Senator Bond:

The undersigned groups urge you to co-sponsor S. 700 “Ending Medicare Disability Waiting Period Act of 2009” sponsored by Senator Bingaman. This legislation would end the unjustifiable two-year waiting period for Missourians with disabilities waiting for Medicare eligibility.

People who become disabled and cannot work receive Social Security Disability Insurance, but they are forced to wait two years until they receive health care services through Medicare. People cannot afford the expensive COBRA coverage during those two years, and many Missourians are not eligible for Medicaid during those two years because the income limits are so low. National statistics show that nearly 40% of people with disabilities go without health care at some point during those two years and 24% have no health insurance for the entire two years.

People with disabilities severe enough to qualify for SSDI need access to health care. We would like to see the two-year waiting period ended immediately, but we support S. 700 which would phase-out the waiting period in ten years and immediately eliminate the waiting period for people with life-threatening conditions.

Again, we urge you to co-sponsor S. 700 and help Missourians with disabilities waiting for health care coverage.
